APPLICATION OF MN AIRLINES LLC, D/B/A SUN COUNTRY AIRLINES FOR AN EXEMPTION AND ALLOCATION OF FREQUENCIES

MN Airlines, LLC d/b/a Sun Country Airlines (Sun Country), pursuant to 49 U.S.C.§40109 and Order 2016-2-12 (2016 U.S.-Cuba Frequency Allocation Proceeding), hereby applies for an exemption order and allocation of frequencies to provide year-round, scheduled foreign air transportation of persons, property and cargo between Minneapolis/St. Paul (MSP) and Havana (HAV), 1-stop via Fort Myers, Florida (RSW), year-round nonstop service between RSW and HAV, and winter seasonal service between Minneapolis/St. Paul (MSP) and Santa Clara (SNU) and Matanzas (VRA) Cuba and a year-round, non-stop between MSP and HAV.

Sun Country proposes to commence twice-a-week, Friday and Monday, year-round scheduled service from Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport (MSP) with one stop at Southwest Florida International Airport (RSW) to Havana's José Marti International Airport (HAV) on Friday, November 11, 2016. Sun Country would further like to commence once-a-

week Saturday, seasonal service from MSP to Juan Gualberto Gomez Airport in Matanzas, Cuba (VRA) on Saturday, December 17, 2016 through April 29, 2017, and once-a week seasonal service from MSP to Abel Santamaria Airport in Santa Clara (SNU) on Sunday, December 18, 2016 through April 30, 2017. Sun Country also proposes a second, twice-a-week, Saturday and Sunday, year-round scheduled service from MSP to HAV to commence on Saturday, December 17, 2016.

Sun Country will provide this new service utilizing Boeing 737-800 aircraft with 162 seats or Boeing 737-700 aircraft with 126 seats.

In support of this application, Sun Country submits the following:

Required Showings

- 1. <u>Applicant.</u> Sun Country is a Minnesota Limited Liability Company with its principal place of business at 1300 Mendota Heights Road, Mendota Heights, Minnesota 55120.
- 2. <u>Citizenship</u>. Sun Country is a citizen of the United States within the meaning of 49 U.S.C. § 40102 (15)(C). The president and more than two-thirds of the officers and directors of Sun Country are citizens of the United States. At least 75 percent of Sun Country's voting stock is owned by citizens of the United States.
- 3. <u>Fitness.</u> Sun Country is presently engaged in scheduled air transportation of persons, property, and cargo pursuant to certificates of public convenience and necessity issued under Section 401 of the Federal Aviation Act. Sun Country is fit, willing and able to perform the foreign air transportation applied for herein. Sun Country has considerable experience serving Cuba from points within the U.S.

- 4. <u>Aircraft</u>. All Sun Country service to Cuba is provided using Boeing 737-800 and 737-700 aircraft. Sun Country's Boeing 737-800 aircraft have a total of 162 seats each with 12 first class seats included. The 737-700 aircraft have 126 seats also with 12 first class seats included. Cargo capacity is 18,540 pounds on the 737-800 and 11,4202 pounds on the 737-700.
- 5. <u>Fuel Consumption</u>. Sun Country's fuel consumption for this service would not exceed the ten million gallon threshold specified in Section 313.4 of the Department's regulations.

Evidentiary Requirements:

- The attached proposed schedule for Sun Country's scheduled service between the
 U.S. and Cuba to commence on November 11, 2016 includes firm dates for
 instituting service, the days of the week for the proposed services and seasonal
 service where applicable. Flight numbers, complete routings, departure/arrival
 times, and cargo capacity are also included.
- 2. Sun Country's schedule is listed in order of preference. For Priorities #1 (MSP/RSW/HAV/RSW/MSP), #2 (MSP/VRA/MSP) and #3 (MSP/SNU/MSP) Sun Country's minimum frequency is proposed. For Priority #4 (MSP/HAV/MSP) Sun Country would accept a minimum of one frequency per week, Saturday or Sunday.
- 3. Between July 2013 and September 2015, Sun Country provided charter service for Cuba Travel Services (CTS) a tour operator based in Miami authorized to arrange trips to/from various cities in Cuba. Sun Country operated charter flights to Cienfuegos (CFG), Camaguey (CMW), Holguin (HOG), Santiago (SCU), Santa Clara (SNU) and Havana (HAV) from Miami (MIA), Tampa (TPA), and New York (JFK) during this time.

4. Sun Country would accept backup authority with a condition that permits DOT to implement the authority within the first year should the primary carrier withdraw from the market and, should the authority not be activated, the authority would expire at the end of one year.

Grant of this application is in the public interest because it will allow Sun Country Airlines to provide quality low fare airline service on the routes between Minneapolis/St. Paul and Ft. Myers, Florida in the United States and Havana, Santa Clara and Matanzas in Cuba.

WHEREFORE, Sun Country respectfully requests that the Department grant the exemption and allocation of frequencies as sought above and grant such other relief as the Department deems necessary and appropriate.
