A. Parties

1. CIMEX (Cuba) was a defendant in the proceeding below, and is the appellant in the present appeal. CIMEX (Cuba) is majority owned by Corporación CIMEX, S.A. (Panama) (“CIMEX (Panama)”). The District Court certified appeals by CIMEX (Panama) and CUPET, defendants in the proceeding below, under 28 U.S.C. § 1292(b) and those parties will shortly be filing a petition for permission to appeal in this Court. Otherwise, there are no related cases.
